After submitting the online application, candidate should take print out of the same, duly signed, and send the print out along with original counterfoil of the fees remitted, copy of certificates proving age, educational qualification, community and creamy layer (in the applicable cases only) to the Registrar, Kerala Agricultural University, KAU P.O., Vellanikkara, Thrissur – 680 656 on or before 20.07.2015. The application form without having the copies of the above certificates and fee receipt should be rejected. Applications received after the due date will not be entertained. The details regarding the payment of fees, qualifications etc. are available in the prospectus. The candidates should read the prospectus carefully before filling the applications.

The courses will be offered only if the number of candidates admitted is above 50% of the total seats.
