2. The sealed cover containing the tender should be superscribed "Rotatory Vacuum Flash Evaporator should be addressed to "Professor and Head, Department of Agricultural Entomology, College of Horticulture, Vellanikkara, Kerala Agricultural University, KAU P.O., Thrissur – 680656". Each limited tender should be accompanied by two crossed Demand Drafts separately for cost of tender and EMD drawn in favour of "Professor and Head, Department of Agricultural Entomology, College of Horticulture, Vellanikkara" payable at the State Bank of India, KAU Campus Branch, Thrissur. The amount payable as GST for the cost of tender must be given as separate crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Professor and Head, Department of Agricultural Entomology, College of Horticulture, Vellanikkara" payable at the State Bank of India, KAU Campus Branch, Thrissur.

DD & Agreement to be enclosed:

- a. DD for cost of tender: 0.2 % of the quoted amount rounded to the nearest multiple of 100, subject to a minimum of Rs.400 and maximum of Rs.1500 + GST @12% (Separate demand drafts)

On receipt of purchase order from this office, the limited tenderer should execute another agreement in Kerala Stamp Paper worth Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred only) and furnish a security deposit of 5% of the cost of the equipment quoted in the form of term deposit/bank guarantee/demand draft drawn in favour of "Professor and Head, Department of Agricultural Entomology, College of Horticulture, Vellanikkara", and payable at SBI, KAU Campus Branch, Thrissur. The format of the agreement can be downloaded from the above website given in item 1. Firms who are exempted from payment of EMD should furnish copy of the currently valid certificate from the Store Purchase Department, Govt. of Kerala.
- 4. The exact specifications, details of make, model, name of manufacturer, country of origin of the item etc. must be clearly specified. Original brochures with detailed technical literature and illustrations of the units quoted are to be included along with the offer. Details of trainings to be offered, warranty, maintenance service contract offered after expiry of normal warranty, availability of spare parts and nearest service centre/service personal available should be indicated. Offers without these are liable to be rejected.
- 5. Evidence of exclusive/authorized dealership/distributorship from foreign principals should be provided along with the offers for overseas products.
- 6. In the case of electrically operated equipment, the circuit diagram will have to be supplied. If the power requirement is beyond 20 Amp/220 volts, then the quote should be inclusive of the new power line drawing and cost for the operation of equipment. This should be quoted separately.
- 7. The cost of the item, insurance and freight (CIF) and charges for delivery of item at Pesticide Residue Laboratory, College of Horticulture, Vellanikkara should be separately stated. We are exempted (regd. with DSIR) from payment of customs and excise duty for our procurements. As we are a public funded research institution a concessional GST rate of 5% is applicable to us. Hence prices quoted should be exclusive of these. Offers shall be made CIF Kochi by airfreight for imported instruments and F.O.R destination for indigenous accessories. For imported items, clearing charges, customs and excise duty (whether applicable) and charges for insuring up to College of Horticulture, Vellanikkara, Thrissur, Kerala against all risks including total loss for CIF value plus 10% should be included in the insurance charge. Prices inclusive of GST and other taxes, transportation charges and Installation charges may be indicated separately wherever applicable. In the case of imported equipment only 80% of the total CIF charge for imported components will be paid as DD/ letter of credit as the case may be against satisfactory shipping documents including certificates of insurance. Bank charges (State Bank of India) incurred in connection with payment against documents through bank will be to the account of the tenderer.

Bid Currencies

Prices shall be quoted in the following currencies:-

- 1. For goods and services that the Bidder will supply from within the Purchaser's country, the prices shall be quoted in the Indian Rupees.
- 2. For goods and services that the Bidder will supply from outside the Purchaser's Country, the prices shall be quoted in any one of the easily convertible foreign Currency.
- 8. The rates quoted should be inclusive of all charges and period of firmness of the quoted prices during which the tenderer is to keep the rate firm, should be clearly stated in the offer. **The period of firmness shall not be a date earlier to 90 days.** The Professor and Head shall have the right to extend firmness period for 90 more days without change in quoted rates.

- 10. The firm shall produce stamped signed pre-receipted invoice (original) in all case where advance/final payment for release of shipping documents are made through bank.
- 11. In the case of imported equipment, all quoted prices with different currencies will be converted to INR for comparison on equitable bases as per the selling exchange rate of State Bank of India on the tender opening (24-05-2018)
- 12. The decision of the purchase committee in finalizing the tenders shall be final and binding.
- 13. If any Bandh/strike/any unexpected holidays occurs on the date of opening of tender, the tender will be opened at the same time on the next working day.
