Each quotation should be accompanied an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of 1% of the total cost of the quoted items (subject to minimum of Rs.1500/-) by way of Demand Drafts separately and EMD drawn in favour of the Dean, College of Forestry, Vellanikkara payable at the State Bank of India, KAU Campus (Branch Code 70670). Late and incomplete tenders and tenders without EMD and Agreement will not be accepted.
- 3. The successful quotationer should execute an agreement in Kerala Stamp Paper worth Rs. (Rupees one hundred only) at the time of supply of items and furnish a security deposit of 5% of the cost of the equipment quoted in the form of term deposit/bank guarantee /demand draft drawn in favour of Dean, College of Forestry, Vellanikkara payable at the State Bank of India, KAU campus (Branch Code 70670).
