SIGNIFICANT WEATHER FOR THE PRECEDING WEEK AT VELLANIKKARA:

The total rainfall received 0.0 mm. the maximum temperature ranges from 33.3°C to 34.3°C, minimum temperature ranges from 21.3°C to 24.1°C. Morning relative humidity ranges from 66% to 95% and afternoon relative humidity ranges from 26% to 58%. Wind speed ranges from 0.9 to 4.4 km/h. Bright sunshine hours range from 5.7 to 9.7 hours. Evaporation ranges from 2.4 to 4.3 mm.

Crop	Crop stage	Pest/ Disease	Advisories		
Paddy	Seedling stage	Leaf folder and Stem borer	As a prophylactic measure, apply 2CC <i>Trichogramm</i> <i>chilonis</i> card per acre to control leaf folder and 2C <i>Trichogramma japonicum</i> card per acre to control ste borer in paddy. Cut the cards in to small pieces and f in different parts of the field in plastic cups. If th attack is severe, spray 3ml chlorantraniliprole per 1 litre of water.		
Banana and Vegetables	-	SpodopteraDestroy the affected leafs along with the spodopterSpodopteraspodoptera attack is severe, spray quinalphos 2ml one litre of water or chlorantraniliprole 3 ml per 10 of water.			
Nutmeg	-	Leaf fall	As a prophylactic measure to control leaf fall nutmeg, spray 2 g of kocide per litre of water and appl 20 g of borax per plant in soil.
