### C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Ernakulum District (RRS Vyttila)

General Advisory: -Prophylactic measures can be taken to control crop pest & diseases. Proper mulching of crops can be followed to conserve soil moisture.

Crop	Pest/ Disease, Crop Management	Agromet Advisory		
Rice (General)	Sheath rot and foot rot	Spray Hexaconazole 5EC 1.5 ml per litre after draining the field		
Coconut	Fruit rot and immature nut fall ( <i>Lasiodiplodia</i> )	Remove fallen nuts from field, spray 10% garlic bulb extract / Carbendazim 1 ml per L / Hexaconazole 1.5-2 ml per L / Carbendazim 12% + Mancozeb 63% WP 2 g per L excluding newly formed inflorescences.		
Turmeric	Leaf blight & blotch	Spray and drench Carbendazim + Mancozeb 2g per litre of water or Mancozeb 3g per litre or 1% Bordeaux mixture. Rotation of crops to be followed strictly. Avoid using rhizomes of diseased plants as seeds. Seed rhizomes to be dipped in Bordeaux mixture for half an hour and dry in shade before storing.		
Tree crops	Pink disease	Drench and spray Hexaconazole 5EC 2ml per litre. Once the rain subsides, cut the affected branches or swab 10% Bordeaux paste or Copper oxy chloride (10g per litre).		
Turmeric, cowpea, elephant foot yam	Sclerotium rot	Store disease free planting materials for next crop. Before storing corms/rhizomes from diseased fields, treat them with 0.2% Mancozeb/Carbemndazim or <i>Trichoderma</i> (5 g per Kg seeds) dissolved in cow dung supernatant or 0.7% Nanma and dry in shade.  Treat seeds with <i>Trichoderma</i> (5 g per Kg seeds) dissolved in cow dung supernatant before planting.		

Fisheries:-This is the time of pond preparation for culturing fresh water fishes. Tilapia and Anabas which can be harvested within a span of six months are good options for fish culture.
