General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District Since there is a chance of dry weather condition due to strong wind and high evaporation, crops should be irrigated, when required. Since the wind speed is increasing, give strong propping to banana and staking to vegetables. Proper mulching can be followed to conserve soil moisture.
