Since there is a chance of dry weather condition due to strong wind and high evaporation, crops should be irrigated, when				
required. Since the	required. Since the wind speed may increase, give strong propping to banana and staking to vegetables.

Rice (Mundakan)	Leaf folder	During cloudy weather condition, there is a chance of Leaf folder attack in Mundakan Paddy. It can be controlled by using trichogramma cards (2CC per one acre). Cut the cards in to small pieces and fix in different regions of the field. If the attack is severe, spray Chlorantraniliprole @ 3ml per ten litre of water.		
Tillering stage	Bacterial Leaf blight	To control and prevent Bacterial Leaf blight in paddy, mix 20 g of cow dung in one litre of water and spray the supernatant liquid by mixing with 20g of pseudomonas.		
Chilli	Thrips	There is a chance of thrips attack in chilli. Apply 2% neem oil garlic emulsion or spray 2 g Thiamethoxam per ten litres of water.		
Bitter gourd	Jassid's	Due to increase in atmospheric temperature, the attack of Jassid's in Bitter gourd was increased. They can be controlled by applying 2% neem oil emulsion once in a week or by spraying <i>Lecanicillium lecanii</i> at 20 g per litre of water.		
Animal Husbandry- Ensure sufficient supply of clean drinking water to the animals. Deworm the animals after dung examination. Vaccinate animals against foot and mouth disease and haemorrhagic septicaemia. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
