New seats in Kerala Agricultural University to B Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture course

The Kerala Agricultural University has decided to allot 25 seats for B Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture course in various categories under its three constituent colleges. Admission to these seats will be conducted in this academic year itself from the candidates included in the KEAM rank list for medical stream courses. The admissions will be conducted only after the final allotment process of the Commissioner for Entrance examination is over for the seats already notified through KEAM-2015.

Among the 25 seats, 16 seats are reserved for VHSC Agriculture holders in the state. In the light of government decision to provide 'EX- CAPF' benefit to the persons retired from paramilitary forces on par with the 'Ex- Servicemen' status of armed force personnel, the University has decided to reserve two seats for B Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture course to the children of persons retired from paramilitary forces.

Already six seats are reserved in the KEAM for Diploma Holders in Agricultural Sciences for Diploma Holders in Agricultural Sciences to B Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture course. Additional six candidates from the KEAM Rank list will be admitted by the University over and above the existing strength under this category. In order to attract more students to agriculture sector, the Government have decided to admit an eminent candidate who have proved his talent in agriculture and won a state level award from the government in the filed of agriculture. The candidate applying to this seat should be a Kerala Native, qualified and ranked in the Entrance Examination for medical stream courses with minimum mark requirements. A high level committee comprising of Agriculture Production Commissioner will be authorized for the selection of a suitable candidate from this category.
