The same will be accepted by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **the Associate Director of Research, RARS(SZ), Vellayani** payable at **SBI, Vellayani** and should be sent separately along with the tender.

2. EMD at 1% of the cost of item including GST offered should be remitted by a separate DD drawn as detailed above.

3. Agreement on Kerala Stamp Paper for Rs.200.00. Form of agreement can be downloaded from the website <http://www.kau.in/tenders> under the Related Documents section.

4. The offer for the item should indicate separately the basic unit, accessories and optional, and its cost. Taxes, customs and excise duty, packing, forwarding, insurance and any other cost for its installation, if any, should also be included.

5. The sealed cover containing the tender document should be superscribed as "Tender for the supply of **Bee hives & beekeeping equipments**" and addressed to the Professor & Principal Investigator, AICRP on Honey Bees and Pollinators, RARS(SZ), College of Agriculture, Vellayani.

6. Tenders received late or incomplete in any respect will be summarily rejected without notice and the decision of the undersigned on such matters will be final.

7. Successful tenderers will have to execute an agreement and remit security deposit @ 5% of the value of the articles ordered, less the amount of EMD, drawn as DD or fixed deposit receipt.
8. The items are to be supplied at the National Level Quality Control Lab for Honey, RARS (SZ), College of Agriculture, Vellayani, Trivandrum 695522.
9. The supplier should give the details of the nearest service centre and response time.
10. Details of warranty after the sale service offered on expiry of normal warranty period available should be mentioned.
11. The undersigned reserves the authority to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.
12. The decision of the undersigned in finalizing the tenders shall be final and binding.
13. Leaflets/ brochures/ catalogues of the equipment in colour describing its features, applications, specifications etc. should be provided along with tender. A drawing of the table assembly should be provided along with tender.
